Points of Note to all competitors in National ICA Competitions:

- 1. Please adhere strictly to the criteria of each specific Competition.**
- 2. There must be at least two entries in any competition for it to be held.**
- 3. Judges decision is final in all Competitions.**
- 4. No Late entries will be accepted.**
- 5. From 2020 onwards, 1st Prize in any competition will only be awarded to the same entrant/team for two consecutive years. Having enjoyed 1st Prize for two consecutive years, the winning entrant/team will not be allowed participate in this competition again for a period of one year.**
- 6. All Cups, Plaques, Shields and Trophies must be returned to the ICA National Competitions Committee one month prior to that competition being run again and 2 months prior to the National AGM**

1. Gempack Baking Competition National Final Wednesday 31st March 2021

The GEMPACK Baking Competition Final will be held in An Grianán on Wednesday 31st March.

The competition is for a "**Carrot & Pineapple Cake with Coconut**" following the attached Edward Haydens Recipe and baked in a large Loaf Tin. One cake per Federation. Proof of Gempack purchases is required at Federation and National Competitions.

The names of the Federation winners must be submitted to National Contest Secretary, **May Campbell**, Doonameran, Kenagh, Co Longford, N39NX24 by **Friday 12th March 2021**.

The Federation Winners will be invited to come to An Grianán on Wednesday 31st March 2021. Registration of the entries will take place at 10.30am. Tea and

coffee at 11am followed by a Cookery Demonstration. All meals, accommodation on the Tuesday or Wednesday night and breakfast on the following day will be sponsored by GEM PACK.

**11. Guild Year Book for the Betty Manning Trophy
Closing Date Friday 26th March 2021.**

The competition for 2020-2021 is to produce a Guild Year Book, which will give details of all guild activities for the year. The Year Book will be from April 2020 to March 2021. The year book will be a record of all the things the Guild does during the above ICA year with and for its members. It should include photographs, reports or anything of relevance to a particular Guild event. The Year Book should promote the Guild by including information on Guild meetings, outings, classes, workshops and activities such as crafts, drama, sports etc. The Year Book should tell of the fun and friendship enjoyed by Guild members and how the Guild met the needs of members throughout the year. The Year Book should tell of charitable work and community involvement. It should celebrate the successes of members and of the Guild. It should speak of Guild involvement at Federation and National level.

It may be hand written and/or computer generated. Presentation will be important. The year book must be A4 size.

The Guild Year Book must be the work of at least three guild members but we would envisage it being a real Guild effort with various people being involved throughout the ICA year, recording events as they happen.
