The project 'Unity in Diversity' has secured funding which seeks to increase participation in learning to women living in communities of need by providing an opportunity to create and access learning opportunities at local level aimed at the provision skills training and/or upskilling, supporting cultural exchange and inclusion, and covering the subject of handcrafts.

Participation in adult learning is an important element for life of adult people which can bring individual and social outcomes. As a result, we are running three handcraft courses for four weeks (one class per week) to address the existing gap for women living across Cork City.

Three handcraft courses will run in different areas of Cork. Each course will be tailored to participants' needs and level of skills through a participatory-led approach.

The number of participants per course is capped to ensure maximum impact for attendees.
